

Lifting the lid on the attitudes towards hospital aids

IOM have published three research papers uncovering the attitudes people have to mechanical lifting aids within hospitals. Work-related musculoskeletal disorders (MSDs), including manual handling injuries are the commonest type of occupational illness in the UK. Back pain and other MSDs account for about 40% of all sickness absence in the NHS. Specialist lifting devices are an important tool in helping patients and preventing injuries to nurses and other healthcare professionals in UK hospitals.
